The Center for Employment Opportunities (CEO) aims to make positive change in our communities. CEO is a non-profit dedicated to working **exclusively with returning citizens & those impacted by the legal system**. We provide individuals **immediate paid work opportunities** and an **extensive support network** to create strong pathways for economic mobility and build long-lasting careers.

Why Should you Refer Individuals to CEO?



DAILY PAY + TRANSPORTATION

Participants work **four days a week** and **get paid at the end of each day** worked. **Free transportation** is also provided to get participants to and from their worksite.



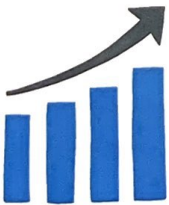
ON THE JOB TRAINING

At CEO we meet individuals where they are; **our paid work opportunities are learning opportunities**. Individuals are provided skills training, daily feedback from their site supervisor, and the space to learn, make mistakes, and grow.



SUPPORT NETWORK THAT WORKS

When individuals are referred to CEO, they are **joining a team of experts** dedicated to understanding them, their career goals, and supporting them on their journey for long-term employment. Our **evidence-based model** has been tested to **increase employment and reduce recidivism**.



RETENTION SERVICES

Individuals who complete our program are offered **one year of retention services** and coaching, including **financial incentives** for meeting certain milestones.

Getting started

Are you currently on parole or probation?

CEO can help you get and keep a job.

Connect with your parole or probation officer

If you are on community supervision, ask your parole or probation officer for a referral form to CEO. Once you are referred, please contact us to schedule yourself for the next available orientation at our office. See contact below.

Attend orientation and get to work

You will enroll in our interactive job-readiness training class (4-5 days long), led by seasoned instructors. Upon completion of the class, you will begin your new job on CEO's transitional work crews. This is a part-time job that is paid daily—not many employers offer that perk!

Find a full-time job

While working for CEO, you'll have access to a variety of free training opportunities and be assigned a job coach who will help prepare you for full-time work. CEO will also conduct outreach to local businesses on your behalf with the goal of finding you a full-time job. If hired, CEO will provide continued support for up to a year of your full-time employment.

Eligibility:

- Referral form from your parole or probation officer, or case worker
- Social Security card and/or birth certificate along with a picture ID
- A desire to work full-time

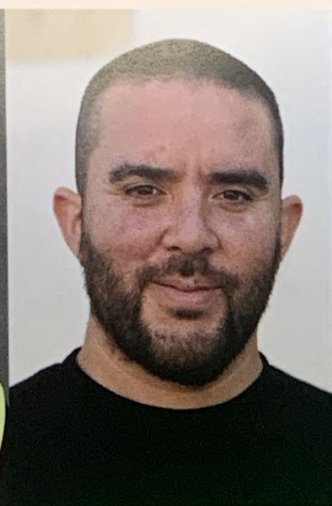
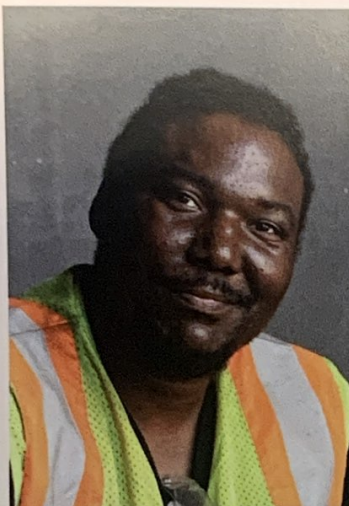

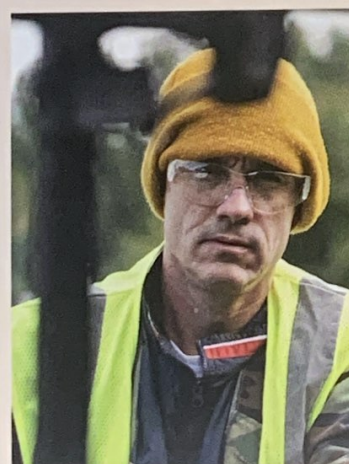
